Where Does the Money Go?

At Life4Kids Canada, more than 95% of the donated funds go directly to the support of 36 little boys in Nairobi, Kenya. In fact, the only overhead costs are bank fees, insurance premiums and audit fees.



In Kenya, Jane runs a "tight ship". At the beginning of each calendar year, Jane estimates the operating costs for the home and for education of the boys. And she lives by that budget, right to the dollar. Jane was able to fund all operations with her budgeted revenues (she needed less than \$400 more than her annual six figure budget). Do you know any business that budgets that well?

Life4Kids Canada is now responsible for almost 70% of that budget.

Update on the Boys

The boys have all successfully completed the 2022 academic year and will move to the next level. All the boys are now at home for a very long holiday (from December 2 until January 22).

Four of the young boys have graduated to Grade 1 with excellent grades. There was a special celebration for them [see picture]. Four more boys have successfully completed their primary education and will be moving on to high school. Another boy has completed his final exam in high school.
