Improvements to the New Home

We were delighted that donations received allowed us to fund needed improvements to the home. Jane reports that "thanks to the generous funds received, we've made significant enhancements to our new residence to ensure a safe and comfortable living environment including:

- Installation of Electric Fence for Security
- Establishment of a Reliable Water Supply
- Implementation of Fire Safety Measures with Extinguishers and Smoke Detectors

- Three Hardwood Dining Tables and 26 Chairs
- Installing External Sinks for Improved Hygiene
- Repair and Upgrade of Outdoor Toilet Facilities
- Provision of New Couches for the Boys' Comfort
- Fitting of Wardrobes for Organized Storage
- Acquisition of a New Office Desk and Two Chairs
- Installation of CCTV Cameras to Enhance Security

Needs for the New Home

Looking ahead, we hope to make the home even more habitable by securing:



- A van for easy transportation
- Addition of a washing machine
- Home Library/Computer Lab
- Recreational Equipment
- Septic Tank Expansion
- External Steel Gas Cage
- Open-Sided Steel Canopy
- Extra Metal Decker Beds and Mattresses
- Railings to Safeguard the Balconies
