Overview

The Midland Rotary Club is cooperating with Life4Kids Canada to plan a mission trip and safari excursion to Kenya. Activities will include visits to the Life4Kids Children's home outside Nairobi in Kenya, working on a project to repaint the home at the Life4Kids Home, and a choice of either (1) spending a few days on safari at Africa's most famous wildlife reserve, The Masai Mara, or (2) touring Nairobi.

Accommodation

While in Nairobi, we will stay at the Eka Hotel 3* (or similar) in Nairobi in standard rooms. Breakfast and tourist taxes included (further details will be available).

While on safari, we will stay at the Mara Serena Safari Lodge 4* (or similar) in a standard room right on the Masai Mara Reserve (further details will be available).

Options

The proposal is to offer two optional itineraries:

- Option 1 - Life4Kids and Safari**
9 nights (3 days at Life4Kids Children's Home; 4 days on safari)
- Option 2 - Life4Kids and Nairobi Tours**
7 nights (3 days at Life4Kids Children's Home; 3 days exploring Nairobi)

Itinerary with Masai Mara (Option 1)

DAY 1	Travel to Nairobi. Overnight at Eka Hotel (standard rooms) with Breakfast
DAY 2	Transport to Life4Kids home; meet boys and staff; begin project
DAY 3	Transport to Life4Kids home; meet boys and staff; continue project
DAY 4	Transport to Life4Kids home; meet boys and staff; finish project
DAY 5	Transport to Masai Mara; Afternoon game drive.
DAY 6	Full day in the Reserve with morning & afternoon game drives.
DAY 7	Full day in the Reserve with morning & afternoon game drives.
DAY 8	Full day in the Reserve with morning & afternoon game drives.
DAY 9	Return to Nairobi and stay at Eka Hotel
DAY 10	Travel home.

November 02, 2026: Breakfast at the hotel. Minibus transit to Life4Kids Children's Home. Lunch at the Home. Work on painting project. Minibus return to hotel. Dinner at hotel (not included)

November 05, 2026: Departure from Nairobi and drive to the Masai Mara with English speaking guide. Skirting Mount Suswa, the road heads north to Maai Mahiu, south of Lake Naivasha, before turning west to Narok and continuing west and south to the Masai Mara. The drive takes approximately 4 to 5 hours, depending on the destination in the Mara (itinerary details and travel time are subject to road conditions). Entrance fees for the Masai Mara National Reserve (valid for 24 hours per day) are included. Arrival and Lunch at the hotel. Afternoon safari. Dinner at the hotel

NOTE: November 05-08, 2026: 4-nights accommodation in Masai Mara at the Mara Serena Safari Lodge 4* (or similar) hotel in a standard room, including full board & tourist taxes.

November 06, 2026: Morning safari with English speaking guide on all safaris. Breakfast. Second morning safari with guide. Lunch at the Lodge. Afternoon safari with guide. Dinner at the Lodge.

Heading north and east towards Narok, the road then turns east to Maai Mahiu, south of Lake Naivasha, and continues southeast to Nairobi. Starting at an altitude of about 1500m in Masai Mara, the road ascends the Rift Valley escarpment to around 2500m before descending to Nairobi (1661m). The journey takes approximately 4 to 5 hours, depending on the starting point in the Mara (itinerary details and travel time are subject to road conditions). Arrival at the hotel. Accommodation in Nairobi at the Eka Hotel 3* (or similar) hotel in a standard room, including breakfast and tourist taxes.

November 10, 2026: Breakfast at the Nairobi Hotel. Transfer from the Nairobi Hotel to the Nairobi Airport. Private group coach and driver. English-speaking assistant/guide.

November 6 - Nairobi City Walking Tour

November 7 - Tour of a slum

The costs of minibus, tour guides, and admission fees (where applicable) for November 5, 6 and 7 are not included in the "tentative costs" provided above, nor are the costs of lunches and dinners for those days.
