His presence reminded us why this work matters, not only for the children who grow up within our home, but for every vulnerable child who crosses our path in a moment of need. Barack

was safely reunited with his mother and sister. This moment reaffirmed that Life4Kids is not just a home, but a place of safety, restoration, and hope for the most vulnerable.
